The BRRHS / DePuy TJ² Robotics Team is starting its fifteenth year this year. This team is part of the FIRST organization whose goal is to match students with professional scientists in a challenging environment. Every year we design, create, and build a 130-pound robot according to game specifications that change every year. We then travel with 40 students around the country to three-day competitions.

Our communities of Raynham, Bridgewater, and beyond have very generously supported us over the years. Our students are required to raise \$700 each to be a member of our traveling team.
