Team Meeting Information

Team Meetings VS Group Meetings

Team Meetings: Every other Friday immediately after school. These meetings are mandatory and used to touch base with all team members and communicate important information.

Fundraising

Expenses \$ 130,700 (based on 2020)

- Travel for Team (~40 students, 30 mentors)
 - Approximately \$70,000 (Ground, air, hotel, meals, activities, etc.)
- Build – \$36,700
- Uniforms - \$8,000
- FIRST & Registrations - \$16,000
- No funding for these expenses from BRRSD

Fundraising Events

- Canal Day, October 2nd, Cape Cod Canal, Herring Run, 10 am – 3 pm
 - Team bonding event (students, mentors, parents/families)
 - Grills, food, supplies
 - Parents to grill, set-up/clean-up, “tracker”, bike repairs (air pump, tire repair, etc.), general chaperoning (sign up at Sign Up Genius and Google Doc in Family Slack)
- Dinner/Auction, December 2nd, 6:30 pm – 11 pm, Bridgewater Vets Club
 - Each student is required to donate a minimum of one new “item” valued at \$25 or more
 - Students may donate as many items as they want; students take in fund-raising credit, based on money brought in
 - Silent auction items VS. Raffle auction items
 - Each student is required to sell 2 tickets to event
 - Students receive \$5/extra ticket fund-raising credit for additional tickets sold
 - Need parent help
 - Set-up for auction on Thurs., Dec. 1st
 - Drivers to transport items and students to hall
